World Day of Prayer is organized by **Women's Inter-Church Council of Canada (WICC)**. Christians from over 170 countries unite together in spirit, on a common day to pray for relevant issues affecting women and children. This movement has been active for nearly 100 years. Each year, a different country writes the service materials. The World Day of Prayer is generally celebrated on the **first Friday of March**. This year's service was written by the World Day of Prayer Committee of **Vanuatu**, a South Pacific Ocean nation made up of roughly 80 islands.
